

Main Rules

1. The *YRW Scoreline competition* will involve all 40 pool games that are being played across the 4 pools. These 40 games will be split into 4 rounds as shown on the match schedule table supplied.
2. Scoring will be based on the 20/20/20 rule;
 - 20 points for picking the game outcome (ie; Team A win, Team B win or Draw)
 - 20 points for picking Team A's exact score with a deduction of 1 point for every point variance to a maximum of 20 points deducted, and
 - 20 points for picking Team B's exact score (same deduction rule as above).

Examples by way of illustration;

	Outcome	Team A	Team B
Your pick	B wins	35	40
Actual score	B wins	10	38
Scores	20	0	18 (total 38)
or			
Your pick	B wins	7	10
Actual score	Draw	7	7
Scores	0	20	17 (total 37)

3. A deadline for entry into each round is, in each case, the working day before the first game of the round. The Round 4 deadline will therefore be Fri, Sept 23.
4. If an entry is not received by the due date, you will automatically be assigned a nil-all score selection.

Fine Print

1. Entries are open to clients of YRW only. The client must be a current fee paying client entity represented by a person over the age of 18 with a maximum of 3 entries per client group. Therefore, if you have a Company, a Trust and a Partnership with all three entities having paid fees to YRW in the last year, you could have up to 3 entries. However, each individual person can only enter once.
2. All competitors' picks will be posted on our website on the first playing day of each round and results of each round will be posted on the first workday following the conclusion of the round.
3. The winner will receive 2 x tickets to the second semi-final match being played at Eden Park on Sunday, October 16th. You will be responsible for arranging your own transport and accommodation requirements for this game.
4. The winner will be required to collect their tickets in person and will agree to have their name and photo included in YRW promotional material and website publications.
5. Should there be 2 or more winners at the end of the competition, then YRW will establish the winner based on a count-back system, or failing that, a coin toss between those winners.
6. All communication will be via email and the YRW website unless otherwise arranged.
7. All decisions made by YRW will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
